Local Rule - Storm Damage.

All fallen trees, tree stumps, fallen trees attached to stumps , trees and branches sawn up and stacked for removal to be treated as Ground Under Repair and relief taken as per rule 25-1. (i.e. Nearest point of relief not nearer the hole, one club length).

Through the Green.

A ball may be marked, lifted, cleaned and replaced without penalty within one club length not nearer the hole.

Bunkers.

All bunkers are Ground Under Repair, relief must be taken per Rule 25-1.
